

GYPSY MOTH REGULATORY PROGRAM---REMINDERS

***ACCURATE STATEMENTS (CERTIFICATION) PAPERWORK MUST ACCOMPANY EACH LOAD THAT IS MOVED OUT OF THE QUARANTINE AREA

***ONE COPY OF THE ACCURATE STATEMENT MUST BE DELIVERD TO MILL—LOGGER MUST KEEP ONE COPY FOR HIS RECORDS

***ALL RECORDS MUST BE KEPT FOR A MINIMUM OF TWO YEARS

***REGULATED ARTICLES CANNOT BE INSPECTED MORE THAN 5 DAYS BEFORE BEING HAULED TO A NON-QUARANTINE AREA

***THE ONLY PEOPLE WHO CAN INSPECT LOADS ARE THOSE WHO HAVE TAKEN THE GYPSY MOTH TRAINING CLASS. THEIR NAME(S) MUST BE LISTED ON THE COMPANY'S COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT

***ALL COMPANY COMPLIANCE AGREEMENTS (YOUR COPY) MUST BE KEPT ON FILE AND AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY NCDA & CS OR USDA PERSONNEL

***ALL GYPSY MOTH SELF-CERTIFICATION STAMPS ARE PROPERTY OF USDA AND MUST BE RETURNED IMMEDIATELY IF COMPANY IS NO LONGER IN BUSINESS

Please see attached reminders for issues regarding Gypsy Moth compliance on wood from the federal quarantine area. While most loggers are doing a good job, I have noticed several lately not COMPLETELY filling out the accurate statements. No inspection (origination) county listed and no date listed are indeed violations and this needs to be corrected ASAP.

If you have any employees or loggers that need additional training, please call me.
