ACCEPTABLE SPECIES: YELLOW POPLAR, CUCUMBER, BASSWOOD, SYCAMORE
 LOG LENGTHS: 8'-10"; 17'-6"
 MINIMUM DIAMETER: 8" inches inside bark at the small end of the log.
 MAXIMUM DIAMETER: 30" inches outside bark at the largest point on the log.
 MAXIMUM LIMB OR KNOT SIZE: Not to exceed scaling diameter when measured at the surface of the log.
 MAXIMUM NUMBER OF KNOTS: A log may have up to 7 sawn off knots on any 8'10" piece.
 LOG ENDS MUST BE SOUND: Scale deductions will be made for holes or dote over 2" inches in diameter. A portion of the log will be culled if the hole or dote exceeds 3" inches in diameter.
 FORKED ENDS OR DOUBLE PITHS: A portion of the log will be culled if this condition exists.
 SPLIT LOGS: Appropriate scale deductions will be made for splits; however, if the split is near the center of the log a portion will be culled.
 FORK OR PISTOL BUTT: A portion of the log will be culled.
 ALL LIMBS MUST BE TRIMMED FLUSH: Logs not properly trimmed will be culled.
 SWEEP: All sweep measurements are based on the 8'-10" block length, even within the longer length logs. The allowable sweep varies by diameter and block. Logs with excessive sweep will be culled.

GENERAL LOG SCALING RULES

- Logs will be scaled with the Doyle Log Rule applied to the average top diameter inside bark.
- Proper scale deductions will be made for defects.
- Logs cut shorter than the minimum length will be scaled back to the nearest acceptable length. **No scale will be given for logs cut shorter than 8'9".**
- Logs cut too long will be culled. 8'10" logs cut longer than 10' and 17'6" logs cut longer than 19' will be culled.
- Logs not meeting the within specifications will be culled.
- The decision of the receiving scaler will be final.
- Normal log receiving hours are 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight, Monday through Friday. **Check with the timber office to verify time before bringing logs.**
- If you have not recently delivered logs to us, check with us for up to date species, grade and price.
- All loggers should leave their mailing address, social security or Federal ID number at our office. **No check or direct deposit will be issued until the information is provided.**
- All prices, specifications, and grades are subject to change without notice.
